April 24, 2016 - Passing Of U.S Army - CSM Roy James - 1953 - 2016

Roy James, U.S. Army - Served in, - Kosovo, Iraq, Bosnia. Retired in 2012. with the Rank of Command Sergeant Major, after 34 years of Service.



After the destruction of the Twin Towers on 9 - 11 - 2001, the 148th was called to duty, to guard a restricted area in Indiana.

Chapter 649 supported the troops by supplying each soldier with a calling card as a Christmas Gift, so that they may be able to call home to their families and children while on deployment.

Once again when deployed to Kosovo, Chapter 649 again made arrangements to supply gift cards to the troops while stationed in Kosovo .

After returning home from Kosovo the 148th presented Chapter 649 with a framed

Mosaic, (which is current on display at Union Twp. Police Department), the U.S.A. Flag, that flew over Kosovo, along with a Certificate of Appreciation.

After learning about Roy being in Hospice, members of chapter 649 agreed to assist Roy's family members with his burial, as so did many other Veteran Organizations. Chapter 649 also presented the family with a Bible.

May 12, 2016 - College Scholarship Winner

VVA Chapter 649 presented its first scholarship award to Rachael Lynn Rivera, a senior at Amelia High School. Chapter 649's scholarship program is intended for children and grandchildren of veterans. Rachael's grandfather, Robert Davis, was a US Army veteran who served between 1948 and 1952.

He was a Construction Equipment Mechanic, serving in both Europe and Korea.

Rachael has maintained a 4.0 GPA during her four years at Amelia High School. She is a participant in the State of Ohio's College Credit Plus (CCP) program which allows High School juniors and seniors to take college courses and receive credit for both high school and college classes. At graduation from High School Rachael will have earned 58 college credits from University of Cincinnati's Clermont campus.

In addition to her class work, Rachael is a member of the Student Council at her high school and is active in other high school organizations. She also works part-time at a local grocery outlet.

Rachael will be attending the University of South Carolina, majoring in International Business.
